INDUSTRY IN THE REGION

The Southwest Indiana region is known for the production of nutritional products, pharmaceuticals, aluminum production and manufacturing, automobiles, auto glass, and plastics.

While a vital manufacturing center, the region had worked to diversify and strengthen its economic base by attracting advanced warehousing and distribution, retailing, healthcare, finance, utility and technology-based businesses to the area.

The local economy is also rich in agriculture, mining, construction, transportation, printing and publishing, communications, government employment, banking, insurance, and wholesale and retail service industries.

TAXES

State-Individuals and businesses pay a 3.4% tax on adjusted gross income. A sales and use tax is imposed at a rate of 7% with food, prescription drugs and items consumed or used in manufacturing being exempt.

County-Local Option Income Tax Vanderburgh County residents pay a 1% tax on adjusted gross income. The rate for nonresidents in 0.25%. A 1% Food and Beverage Tax is levied on meals and beverages bought for immediate consumption from a retail merchant, i.e. restaurants, taverns, caterers and grocers.

Property Tax

The county assesses property tax on real estate. such as land and buildings, and personal property, such as campers, mobile homes, machinery and business inventory. Real estate taxes in Indiana are assessed against the property and become a lien in January of every year. They are not due and payable, however, until the following year when they are paid




